- 2. One (1) member from the Robinson-Superior 1850 and/or Treaty #3 Territories

Qualifications:

Candidates must:

- have relevant education and/or work experience related to business and economic development;
- possess a strong financial background;
- be familiar and knowledgeable with business development in Northern Ontario First Nations, including remote First Nations;
- be at least 18 years old;
- not have been declared incapable under the laws of a Canadian province or territory, or by a court in a jurisdiction outside Canada;
- be an individual (that is, a corporation cannot be a director);
- not be in bankrupt status; and
- currently not hold a political position.
